## **WELCOME TO GROSVENOR PARK OPEN AIR THEATRE!**


# This pack will let you know a little bit more about Chester's favourite activities!

Grosvenor Park Open Air Theatre and Moonlight Flicks are produced by Storyhouse.

They are both located in Grosvenor Park, in the heart of Chester city centre. If you are using a sat nav, use postcode CH1 1QQ (Vicars Lane). You can also follow the AA Road Signs to Open Air Theatre.

The nearest car park is the NCP at Pepper Street (follow the AA Road signs for parking and Grosvenor Park Open Air Theatre) and disabled parking is available.

#### **ASSISTED SHOWS**

Every show for Grosvenor Park Open Air Theatre will include captioning of the shows dialogue.





The shows and films within the park also have a more relaxed setting than a

traditional theatre production and cinema.

### **ACCESS REGISTER**

We operate an access register where we will keep you updated about any accessible performances or screenings taking place. Anyone who requires a carer or essential companion to accompany them to events, can do so at no additional charge once registered.

### **PARK ENTRANCE**



This is what Grosvenor Park looks like from the outside. This entrance on Vicar's Lane is the closest one to the open-air theatre.

### **GROSVENOR PARK OPEN AIR THEATRE ENTRANCE**



There is flat level access throughout the park but you will need to travel over a small area of grass to reach the open-air theatre.

#### **THE BAR**



The bar inside the tipis will be open before the show starts and you can purchase, drinks, snacks and meals from here. There are also lots of places to sit down to relax.

### **FOOD**



You can purchase food from us when you arrive or you are also welcome to bring your own food along with you.

# THE STAFF / VOLUNTEERS



You will see lots of staff around when you arrive.
Our staff members and volunteers will have red lanyards around their necks.
They are always happy to help should you have any questions.

## **TOILETS**



The toilets, including accessible are approximately a 2-minute walk from the theatre. There are also signs to show you where these are located.

# **PERFORMANCE**

Your ticket will tell you the time that your show will begin.

You can take your seats up to an hour before the show starts. The actors will enter the theatre when the show is about to begin.

# **THEATRE ENTRANCE**



The doors for all events will open 60 minutes before the show start time. If you need to access the space earlier, please see a member of the team who will try to accommodate your request.

## **SEATING**





There are different types of seating available in the theatre. There are some steps involved in the higher seating but handrails are available.

## **BRINGING OWN CHAIRS**

For Moonlight Flicks you are welcome to bring your own chairs with you or you can hire one of our deckchairs when you purchase your tickets.



## **HEADPHONES**



To hear the film, you will need to use a set of headphones. These are available from a member of the team when you arrive or you can bring your own.

# **SINGING**

Some members of the audience may sing along to the film if it is a musical. Feel free to sing along



## **AFTER A SHOW**



At the end of the show, the audience will clap, feel free to join in and let the actors know that you enjoyed the show.

Everyone will then start to leave the theatre. Please take your time on your way out as these spaces can be very busy.
