
STORYHOUSE THEATRE

The theatre within Storyhouse changes its layout throughout the year. Please find the access information for each layout below;

PROSCENIUM

There are three seating areas across three levels in this mode: the Stalls on the ground floor, the Circle on the first floor, and the Gallery on the second floor.



GALLERY

The Gallery can be accessed via the main staircases or Front of House Lifts The Gallery is a majority stepped configuration, the only row that has flat level access is Row A, this is also where the two wheelchair spaces are located.

CIRCLE

The circle can be accessed via the main staircases or Front of House Lifts
The circle is a majority stepped configuration, the only row in the circle which offers flat level access is row B, this is also where the two wheelchair spaces are located.

STALLS

The Stalls are on a gentle slope from rows A - M and there is flat level access available to these seats via the ramp leading to **Door D**.

There are 4 wheelchair spaces located in the stalls.

THRUST

In Thrust mode, the floor level raises up to the Circle level, and the stage comes out, making the seats wrap around the stage creating a more intimate setting. There are three seating areas across two levels in this mode: the Stalls (now reconfigured) and the Circle are both on the first floor, with the Gallery on the second floor.

CIRCLE & GALLERY

The details regarding access into the Circle and Gallery are the same as the **Proscenium** layout. Please see the notes above.


STALLS

In this layout the stalls are accessed via the Circle level which can be reached via the main staircases or Front of House Lifts.

The Stalls in this mode are long banks of seats that are accessed via a few steps down.



SEATS



The picture on the left shows an example of what the seats within the theatre look like.

In the **Proscenium** layout, seats within the stalls are stalls seats are 420mm wide (between arms) and 447mm deep.

In the circle, seats are 549mm wide (between arms) and 564mm deep.

In the Gallery, seats are 574mm wide (between arms) and 577mm deep.

The picture on the right shows one of our wheelchair spaces located in the stalls.

A standard size wheelchair can fit within any wheelchair space in the theatre.

If you have a larger chair, spaces TO and T24 in the stalls (Proscenium) or spaces B2 and B34 in the circle (Proscenium & Thrust) are the best spaces to book.
